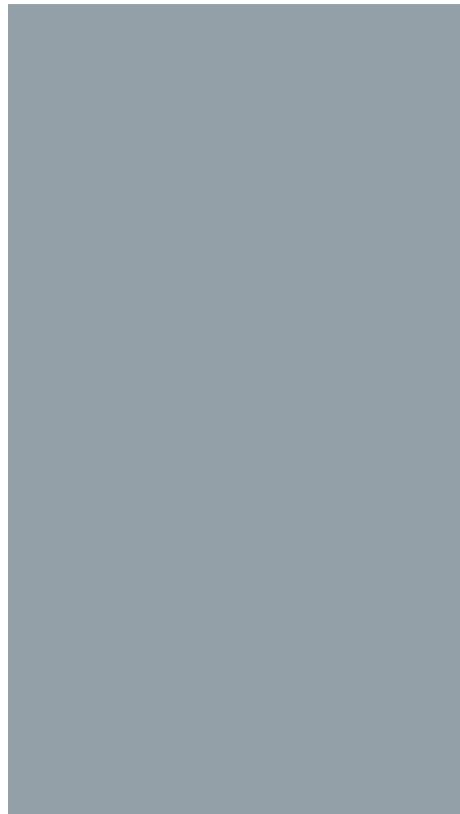
Primary Colors

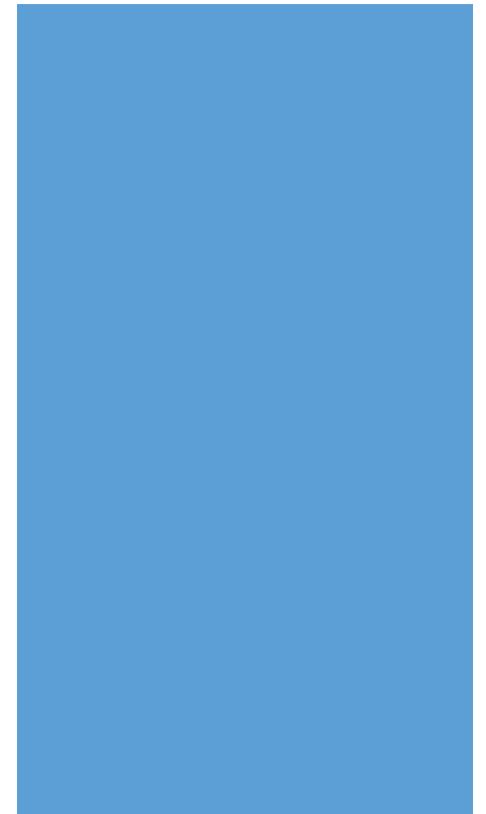

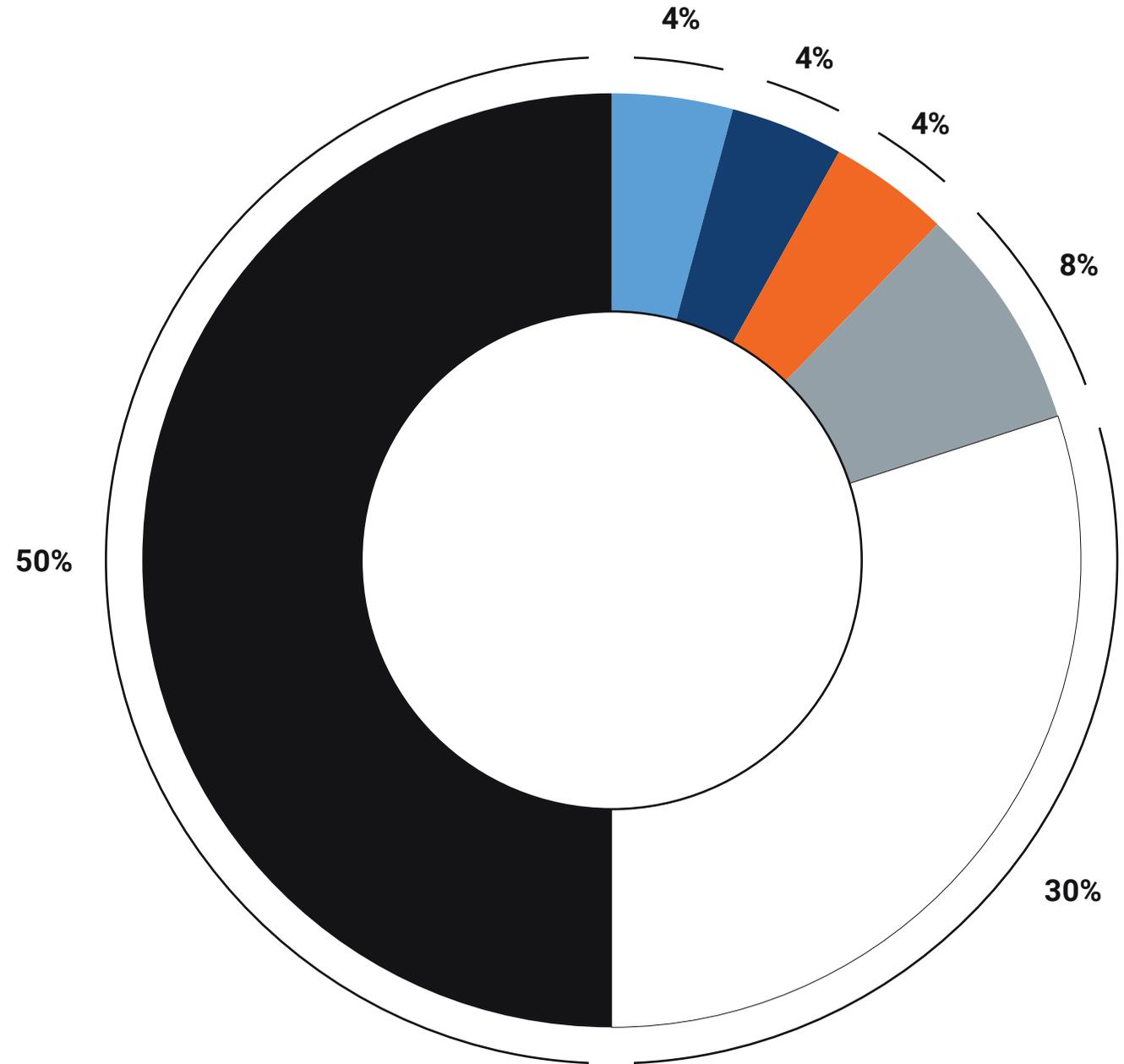
Colors Usage

Use Grey, Dark blue and Orange more frequently in illustrations, UI screens, call-outs, etc.

Light Blue should be used sparingly for highlight purposes..

You shouldn't need to use more than three colors in any particular application. In most applications, two colors should be more than enough. Use color sparingly and with purpose. The sample setting listen here shows three colors in use.

Eurostile is a sans-serif typeface chosen for its human qualities and expressive italics. Eurostile Text and Text Italic can be used in lowercase, sentence case, and all caps.

Eurostile Text Italic can only be used as an accent or add a callout when necessary. The italic font should be used very, very sparingly and used with intention.

Eurostile Bold and Bold Italic should only be used in all caps with extended spacing at small sizes.

Eurostile is used for headlines, callouts and body copy as needed.

Roboto Details

Roboto has a dual nature. It has a mechanical skeleton and the forms are largely geometric. At the same time, the font features friendly and open curves. While some grotesks distort their letterforms to force a rigid rhythm, Roboto doesn't compromise, allowing letters to be settled into their natural width.

This makes for a more natural reading rhythm more commonly found in humanist and serif types.

Roboto is used for subheads and body copy.

Type Hierarchy

The way we use type is crucial to making our designs look thoughtful and professional. Use these tips to make sure the typography is consistent.

You shouldn't need more than three weights in any particular design. In most applications, two weights should be more than enough. The sample setting listed here should three weights in use.

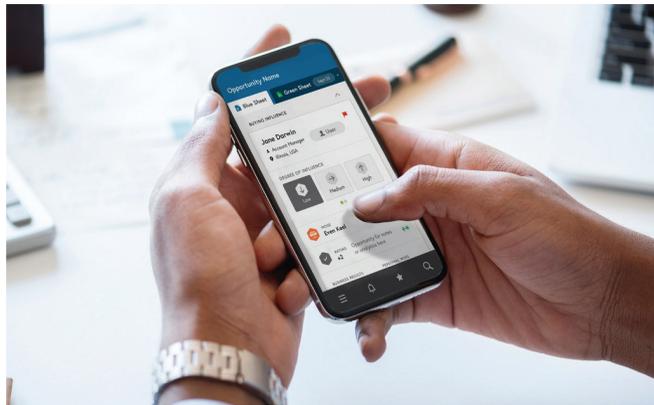

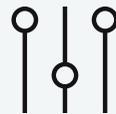
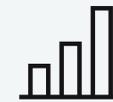
Iconography Overview

When needed, iconography can be applied to help make complex content more digestible. Like other graphic elements within the brand guide, it's critical that iconography be applied consistently and intentionally.

Just Add Power's icon language is universal, minimal, flat and airy. Consistent with the brand's serious personality, icons are reduced to their essential components, prioritize meaning, and are not playful, illustrative or whimsical.

When selecting or building new icons, consider the following guidelines:

- Practice minimalism and reduce symbols to their essential components
- Apply consistent stroke weights and compositional scale across the icon set



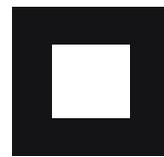
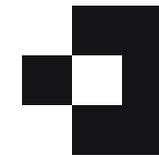
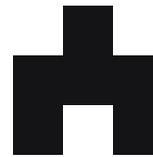
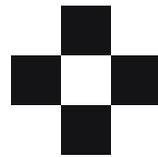
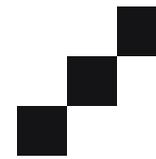
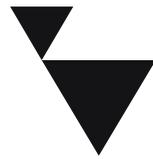
07 Glyphs

Note: Glyphs are shown in black but may be any of the primary palette colors.

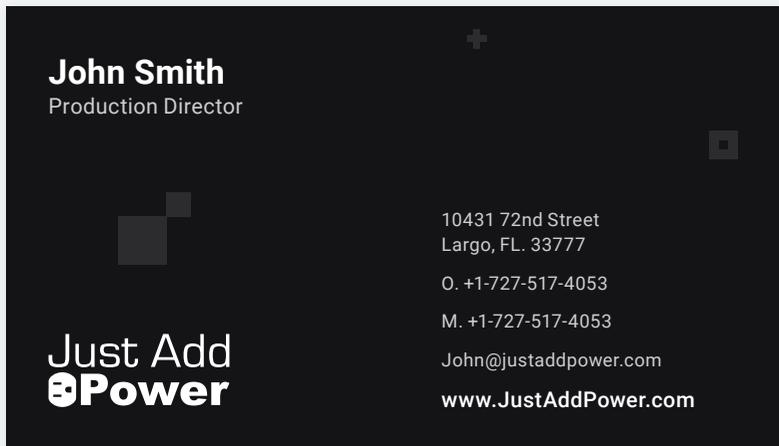

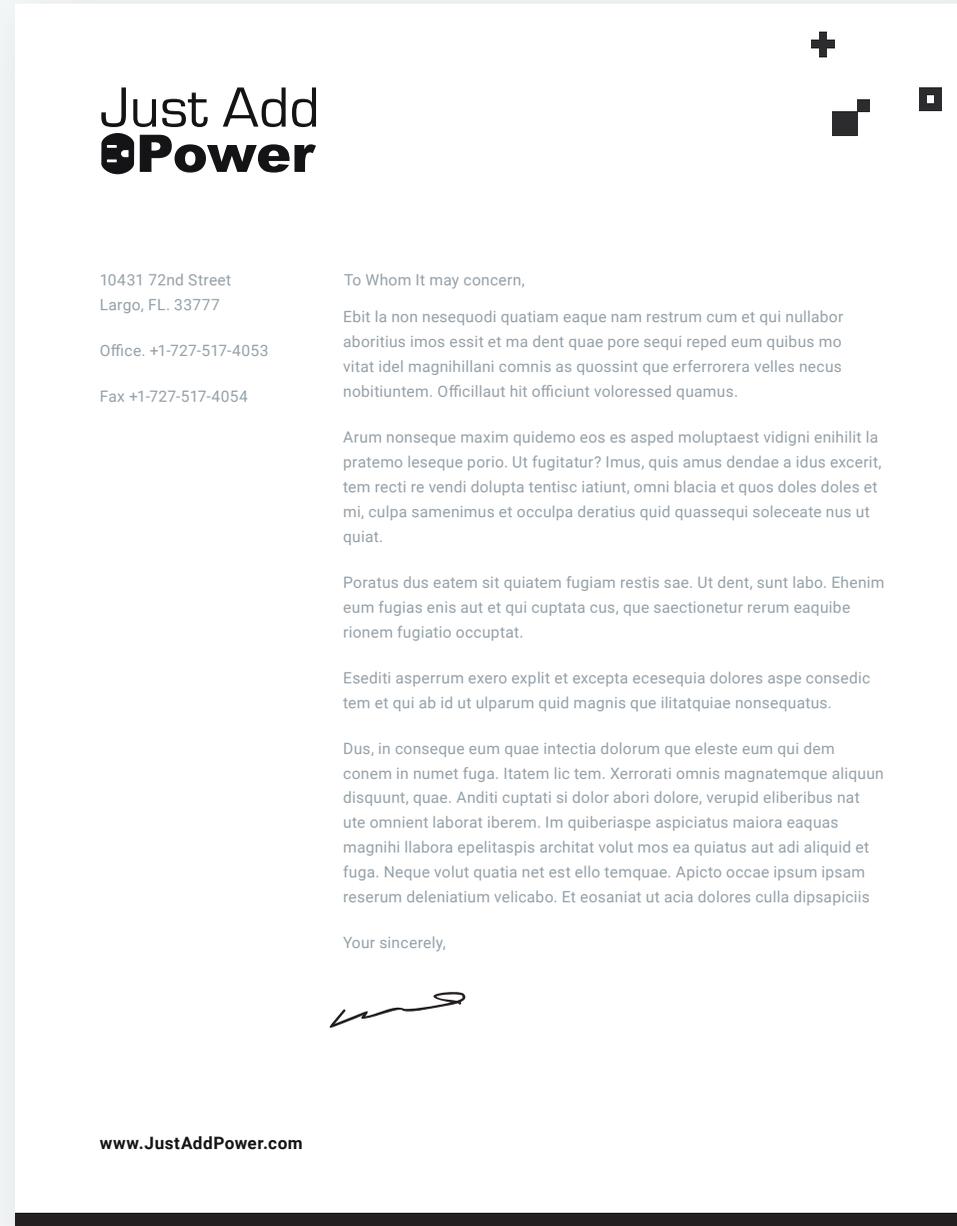

Guiding Principles

Our brand voice is the distinct verbal tone that we use in our communications. Think of it as our unique personality in the marketplace—it helps us create deeper, more immediate connections with our audiences.

When applied consistently, our brand voice helps us build a strong and recognizable brand, setting us apart from our competitors and creating a clear impression of who we are.

BRAND GUIDE

Confident

We are experts in our field, the history and the technology—and we'll always look to share our knowledge without ego.

Kind

We are deeply attuned with our customers' needs, we know that each person's solution will be unique. We embrace opportunities for tailored, warm, messaging.

Welcoming

We let our customers know that Just Add Power is open to all, and speak in a calm and inviting tone.

VOICE & TONE

Direct

We speak in a straightforward manner with our customers, we don't beat around the bush, use euphemisms or give more information than is needed.

Optimistic

We aren't focused on our customers' frustrations, we use positive language that emphasizes potential and opportunity.

Radical

We are a bold reminder to be open minded and shift our current perceptions, we use language that catches attention and encourages scalability.

Style Tips

BRAND GUIDE

Active

Use active voice, avoid passive voice.

Keep it simple

Use short words and sentences, avoid modifiers and fluff.

First person

Addressed to the second person. We refer to J+P as 'we' and our customers as 'you.'

VOICE & TONE

Be optimistic

Write in positive language, never negative.

Avoid jargon

Use words and terms that anyone will understand.

Balance

Balance the scientific with the mysterious and inspiring.

Voice tactics

When crafting written communications to be on voice, refer to these pieces of tactical guidance.

The tips can help you understand how to dial up certain elements of the voice (for instance, a service outage email might need to sound more human than bold). They can also help you avoid common pitfalls.

DO	DO NOT
<p>Simplify, simplify, simplify. Always understand the single key point of each paragraph, and sentence. Make sure the takeaway is obvious—get to it in as few words as possible.</p>	<p>Don't bury the important key points of your communication with fluff. Avoid setting up your point by talking at length about the market context.</p>
<p>Use active, unique verbs. Use verbs that are specific—verbs that evoke a sense of change and progress. Our products “transform” and “communicate.” They don't “leverage” and “enable.”</p>	<p>Don't write in the passive voice. (E.g, “Seamless interoperability is enabled by...” “J+P has been named the best company...”)</p>
<p>Create a sense of motion. We are unstoppable, and words like “propel,” “go,” and “far” communicate that.</p>	<p>Don't use the expected corporate diction that makes you sound smart (at least in theory), but causes readers' eyes to glaze over: utilizes, leverage, etc.</p>
<p>Be completely unflinching. We don't back down, and you can feel that in our writing. Set the tone with short sentences, impactful statements, and inspiring calls to action (“Let's go.”).</p>	<p>Don't bury the lead. Get to the big idea or the core value in the first paragraph, or better yet—the first sentence.</p>
<p>Stay grounded. Just because we speak in extremes doesn't mean we sound frantic or lack reason. Ground our boldness with a degree of mature calm. Support our claims with statistics and facts.</p>	<p>Don't give off a feeling of over-eagerness or immaturity. Stay away from exclamation points or cute phrases. For example, the phrase “Let's go.” (with a period) is good—it conveys a sense of determination. In contrast, “Let's go!” sounds overeager.</p>
<p>Focus on the benefit to the customer. Stepping into the customer's shoes should become an everyday technique. We must see through our audiences' eyes.</p>	<p>Don't focus on our own capabilities. We do want to express the value of our offerings in the boldest terms. We don't want to wax poetic about how our technology works.</p>
<p>Bring passion into the work. Take the time to understand what's exciting about your topic and highlight it. Frame ideas around the emotional benefits—or future possibilities—that idea promises.</p>	<p>Don't write sentences that are laundry lists of functionality or long technological explanations. Always ask, “How can I help explain this more empathetically (without using more words)?”</p>

Writing for Social Media

We use social media to build relationships with J+P users and share all the cool stuff we do. But it also creates opportunities to say the wrong thing, put off customers, and damage our brand. So we're careful and deliberate in what we post to our social channels.

Our writing for social media should generally follow the style points outlined in the Voice and tone sections. Here are some additional pointers, too.

Write short, but smart

Some social media platforms have a character limit; others don't. But for the most part, we keep our social media copy short.

Twitter: 280 characters.

Facebook: No limit, but aim for 1-2 short sentences.

Instagram: No limit, but try to keep it to 1 sentence or a short phrase. Feel free to throw in an emoji.

To write short, simplify your ideas or reduce the amount of information you're sharing—but not by altering the spelling or punctuation of the words themselves. It's fine to use the shorter version of some words, like "info" for "information." But do not use numbers and letters in place of words, like "4" instead of "for" or "u" instead of "you."

Hashtags

We employ hashtags rarely and deliberately. We may use them to promote an event or connect with users at a conference. Do not use current event or trending hashtags to promote Just Add Power.

Trending topics

Do not use social media to comment on trending topics or current events that are unrelated to Just Add Power.

Be aware of what's going on in the news when you're publishing social content for Just Add Power. During major breaking news events, we turn off all promoted and scheduled social posts.

Social Best Practices

Lead with photography from Just Add Power’s approved photo style to stay true to brand voice .

Keep posts simple, clean, higher end and take more risks.

Shows a clear point of view, unique to J+P.

Try to make sure the images are well lit and bright.

Do not post images in collage. It is better to post multiple images rather than to make images smaller and post them all at once.

Do not over-stylize images, no HDR or heavy filters.



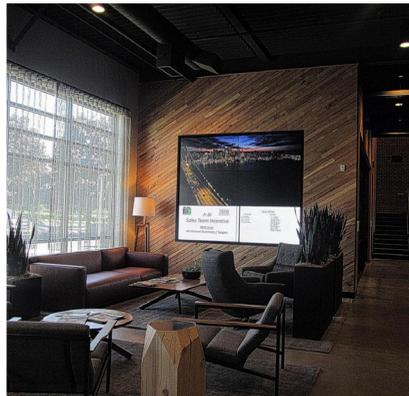

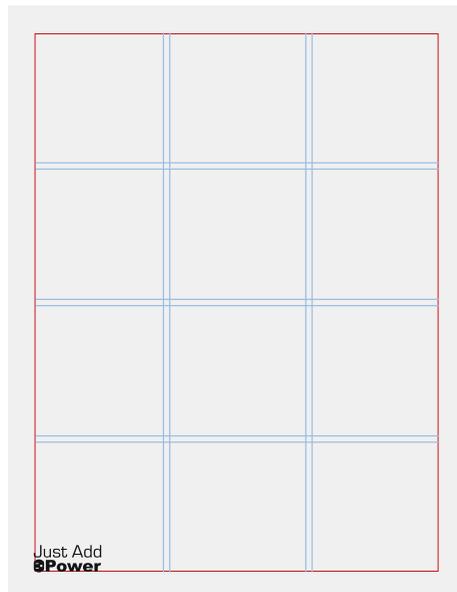
Grids and Glyphs

Glyphs can be placed over photography or behind large headlines in layouts.

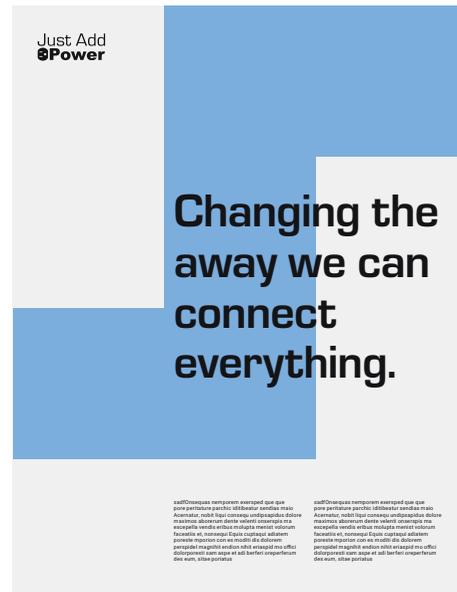
The goal is to create visual rhythm, place glyphs. Maintain their vertical alignment by never rotating them at angles other than 90 degrees.

When using the glyphs, make sure to always use different glyphs, and place them at a distance from one another

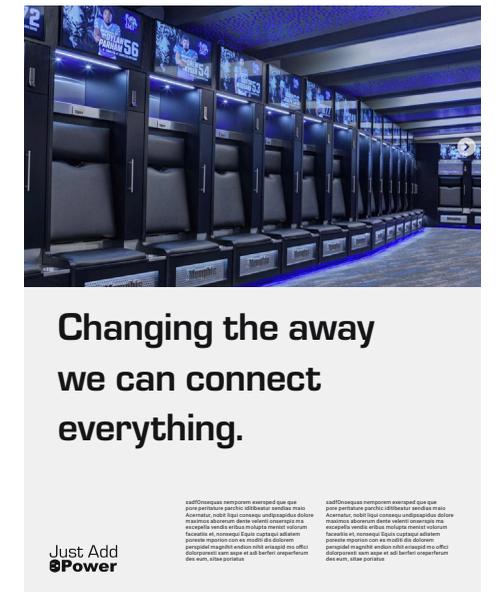
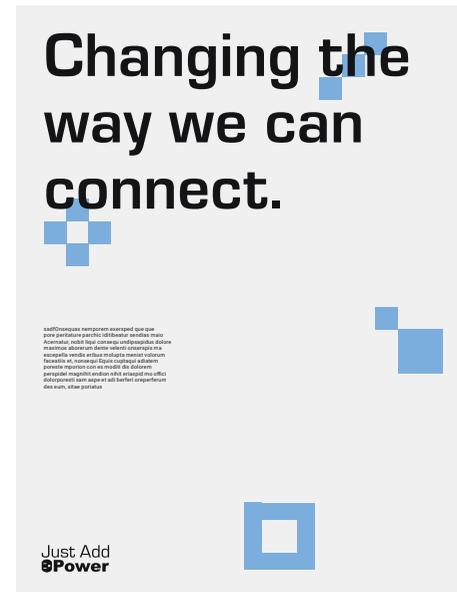
The number of glyphs used in layout should be determined by the overall size of the communication. Generally, the optimal range is three to five glyphs in a single layout.



Basic Grid



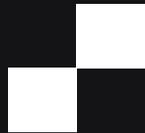
Main Cover that does not include photography, type may overlap the glyph.
